The text is a complete reprint of the previously published 2010 6th edition of the Annotated Act.

If you would like to make a donation with your purchase, the Foundation would be most grateful. I will match it from the proceeds of each sale. Although the circulation of the text is reasonably small, I would, as before, expect that a reasonable number of eye operations could be paid for by subscribers in Tasmania and elsewhere.
