The Tribunal hears and determines applications under Part 4.7 of the *Legal Profession Act 2007*, in respect of complaints against practitioners.

The Tribunal consists of ten practitioners appointed by the Judges from a panel of fifteen nominees provided by the Society and the Tasmanian Bar.
