

## **Directors of the Centre for Legal Studies Ltd – Call for Expressions of Interest**

### **Background**

The Centre for Legal Studies Ltd is a company limited by guarantee, whose objective is to oversee the Tasmanian Practical Legal Training Course which provides legal graduates with instruction in the duties of a legal practitioner in accordance with the requirements of the Legal Profession Act 2007 and relevant regulations.

The course is a post-graduate professional legal training program that leads to the award of a graduate diploma in legal practice and eligibility for admission to the Supreme Court of Tasmania.

The CLS has five Directors, 3 are nominated by the Law Society of Tasmania, one by the University of Tasmania and one by the Board of Legal Education.

The Directors oversee the conduct of the course and the organisation's strategic direction. Directors are responsible for reviewing the performance of the CLS including compliance with national competency standards and the performance of staff and contracted lecturers.

Directors meet approximately 8 times a year.

Legal practitioners with an interest in the practical education of legal graduates are encouraged to lodge an expression of interest.

### **Number of Directorships**

All three of the Law Society nominated Directorships are available. The Society encourages practitioners of all levels of experience to consider applying.
